Here are just a few ways we made Logan County and the surrounding areas healthier in 2017.

Delivering high quality patient care and supporting our physicians

The most important contribution we make to our community is providing high quality care close to home. Quality and service are at the center of how we care for our patients, and we continually invest in our facility to ensure we can meet the healthcare needs of our community. In 2017, we made **\$768,558 in capital improvements**, including a plasma coagulator and bronchoscopes for our surgery department and numerous AHU replacements for the hospital and our physician office building.

Creating excellent workplaces for our employees

We strive to create an environment where talent is recognized, job satisfaction is valued and our **208 employees** can effectively use their skills in providing high quality care and service; and we managed and distributed an **annual payroll of \$11,271,871**.

Supporting local organizations and delivering healthcare to all of our neighbors, regardless of their ability to pay, are foundational to our commitment to the overall well-being of our community.
